

### Objective

By 2023, FinCo Fuel Group aims to emit 30% less CO<sub>2</sub> than in 2019.



Scope 1: **9.392,7 ton**  
Scope 2: **19,2 ton**  
Business travel: **7,4 ton**



**Emissions kg CO<sub>2</sub>/m<sup>3</sup> per transported product:**

2019 > **4,73** | 2020 > **4,90** | 2021 > **3,53**

### In 2020 FinCo Fuel has further sharpened its ambitions,

Part of this is to further reduce the CO<sub>2</sub> footprint on both products and processes through the reduction system in accordance with the CO<sub>2</sub> Performance Ladder 3.1 with attention to registration and implementation.

### How we reduce CO<sub>2</sub>

- Time charters on HVOx
- LED lighting at depots
- Encourage use of public transport
- Encourage electric driving
- Introduction of a bicycle plan
- Compensate for air travel via KLM Biofuel Programme
- Use biological lubricants
- Install solar panels where possible
- Entire organization on biogas
- Entire organization on 100% green electricity
